Subject: NOTICE OF VIOLATION - FAILURE TO MONITOR, EMIGRATION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT UTAH18143

Our records indicate that your system is in violation of the State of Utah Public Drinking Water Rules as follows:

Analytical results of required sampling have not been reported to the Division of Drinking Water for the following sources and chemical contaminant groups:

WS004, UPPER FREEZE CREEK WELL Radionuclides

The above samples should have been taken during the compliance period of 1/1/2014 through 3/31/2014. Failure to comply with Water Quality Monitoring Requirements is in violation of Section 309-205 of the Rules.

You must notify all consumers within one year of the violation (see Section 220-7 of the Rules). This public notice requirement cannot be waived once a violation has occurred. You may provide the notice by mail to each customer, or by posting a notice, or in your Consumer Confidence Report. A copy of the notice you send to each customer must be forwarded to us within one year of the date of this letter. Please refer to the enclosed example of a public notice.

You are advised to complete the required monitoring and submit the analytical results as soon as possible. If you have completed the required sampling, and feel this letter is in error, please submit copies of the analytical reports without delay.
