We live at 3980 Emigration E Canyon Rd.

Emigration Creek, which runs directly through our backyard, has been dry for over a month. We are seeing a lot more deer in the back lot and creek bed seeking water.

As a point of reference when we purchased our home in 1983 the creek was high enough for our children to float downstream on inner tubes and was the home to a school of trout near our bridge. We enjoyed the robust flow for about the first 15 years we lived here. During the last 15 years we experience sporadic losses of the stream flow. The stream seems to be drying up earlier and staying dry for longer periods in this and recent years. It is very sad for us to witness the impact this is having on the environment and the wildlife. We are very concerned about the health of our well. We are seeing much more sediment in our water, particularly when the creek dries up.
