Dear Mr. Jones,


I am writing this letter to protest both permanent change applications filed by the EID, (Emigration Improvement District), as stated above. I am enclosing one check for \$30.00.

As stated in my letter dated April 17, 2018, there continues to be quality and quantity impairment of the water in my well with increased particulate and mud. I have a superior water right to that owned by the EID dating back to May 11, 1984 (#57-8582).

Furthermore, it appears that your office was informed in April 2017 of impermissible water use at 46 homes in the canyon. As the canyon stream is now dry, I expect your office to investigate and take immediate action against water use without a valid water right.

I respectfully request that your agency deny these change applications filed by the EID to prevent further theft of my privately owned well water, in their attempt to pay for the Emigration Oaks water system built by The Boyer Company and City Development, Inc., as well as the proposal to build over 500 new homes in the canyon.
