Mr. Jones,

I have been a resident of Emigration canyon since 1984. I have seen the creek flow decrease in the past few years, with this year the creek went dry in August and it still has not started to flow on my property. The Emigration improvement district is drying out the ground water slowing the flow of the creek.

Is it in the best interest of all who live in the canyon to drill 5 more wells? The EID has no monitoring of how much they pump. Could over pumping the aquifer be the problem with creek flow and diminished water quality in the wells on the main canyon road area?

I believe the loss of water quality and quantity as seen my residents of the canyon form wells and Emigration Creek, correlates with the implementation of the large wells to the extent that causation is now indicated.
