Dear Mr. Jones,

This letter is intended to update my previous protest from March 20, 2018.

Since my last correspondence, I waited 3 days for the cloudy water from my well to clear up and then took a quick shower and washed 1 load of clothes, which caused the water to go cloudy and somewhat red (part way red) which indicates iron oxide from low water levels in my well.


Last year, I could wash 3 loads of clothes and take a long bath and the water always remained clear -- much better than this year even at the end of the summer.

My well is much worse than last year and barely useable even though it is the time of the year for spring run-off and my well should be the highest level of the year. I have very grave concerns that my well will produce NO WATER AT ALL later this year.

I have been informed that EID may be providing water service to 45 homes in Emigration Oaks without the approval of the Utah State Division of Water Rights. If this is true, I demand that you take IMMEDIATE action to prevent illegal use of water in Emigration Canyon -- my home and my life depend on it.
