Subject: Water System Violation – Water System #UTAH18143

According to Division of Drinking Water records, your system has failed to submit a Consumer Confidence Report with its accompanying certification letter for the calendar year 2009.

Failure to submit this report is a violation of Section R309-225-5 of the rules. This violation will result in the addition of 2 points to your system's Improvement Priority System Report (IPS) and could adversely effect your water system's rating (R309-400).

In order to document compliance with the rule, a copy of the report must be delivered to the Division of Drinking Water by July 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. A certification letter stating how the report has been delivered or made available to the customers must also be delivered to the Division by October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Your water system will be returned to compliance and the IPS points will be removed if the 2010 Consumer Confidence Report is received by DDW by July 1, 2011.

EPA requires that we provide them with a list of systems that have not complied with this requirement. Your water system appears on the list and EPA may take enforcement action against your system. We therefore request that you give this matter your immediate attention.
